This series is an excellent choice when retrofitting to the new refrigerants which are HCFC based such as R-401A (MP-39), R-401B (MP-66), R-402A (HP-80), R-402B (HP-81). When retrofi tting a compressor to a new refrigerant, always follow the OEM's recommendation. The Alkylbenzene series is specially filtered to meet its high standard of purity.
